## Relish

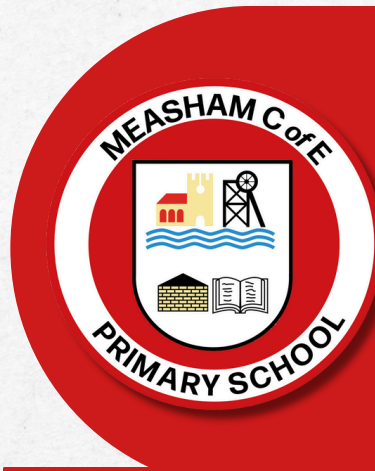
Our Catering provider Relish are hosting a theme day menu on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2025. Please order through Relish via the link below.

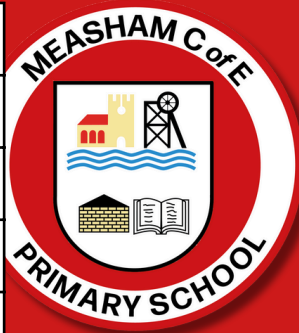

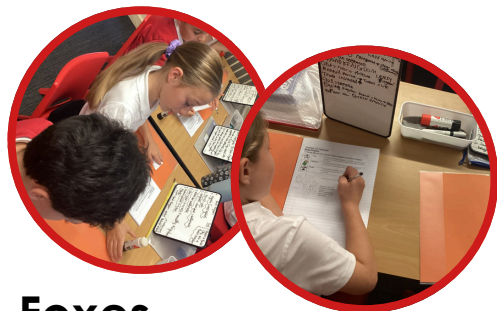
## Badgers

In Year 4, we have been learning about rivers and the British Isles. We've also been exploring the water cycle and how it plays a vital role in our environment.

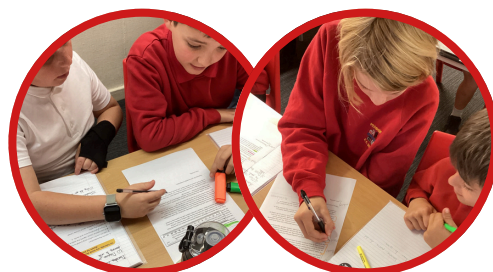


## Owls

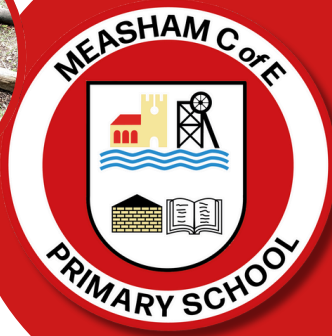
## ELSA
