
Pre-School


Year - 5 Owls

If you have any soft toys, teddies, small world, board games or any other toys at home that are no longer needed, we would be very grateful for any donations.


These will help us provide a wider range of activities for children to enjoy indoors during wet playtimes.

Thank you for all your contributions for Mental Health Day. You have raised a fantastic **£106.80** which will be used for Mental Health resources by our Elsa provision within school.




